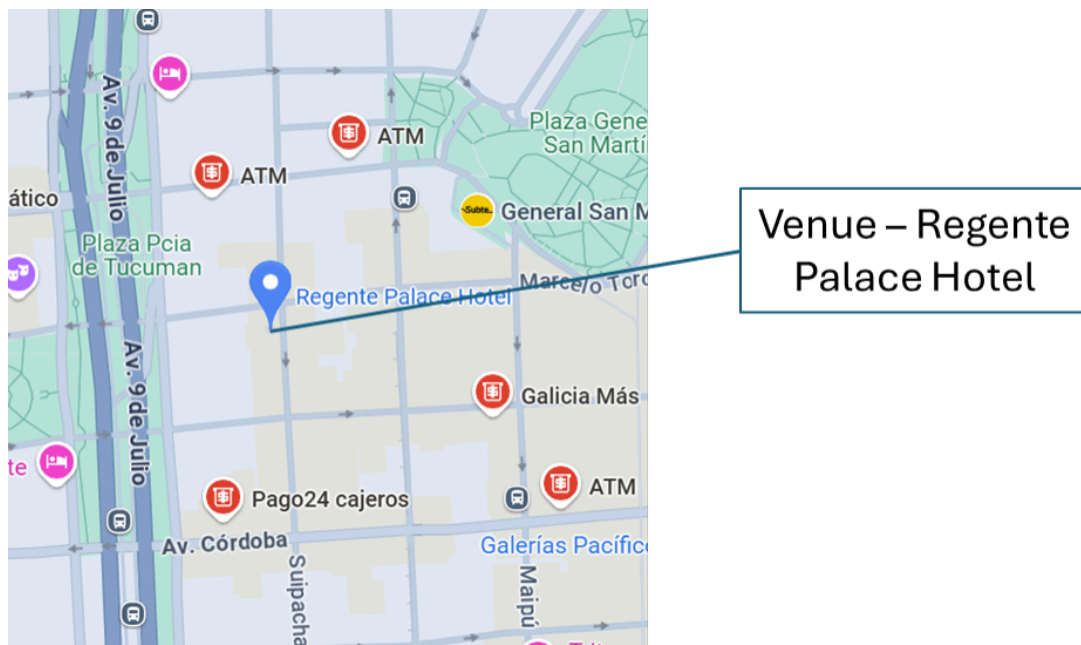
Announcements / Cancellations

ATMs around the Venue

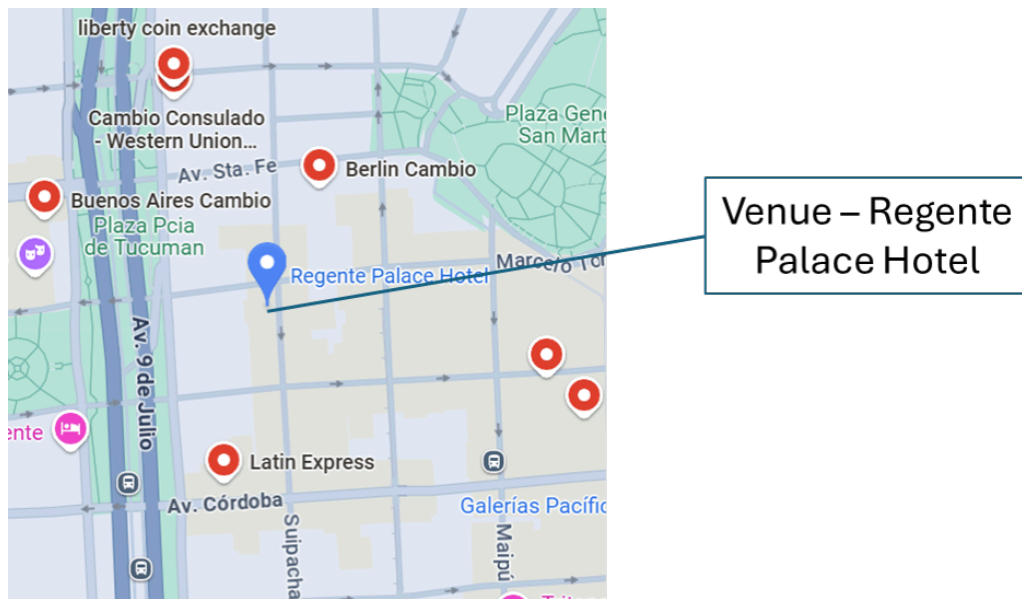


Money Exchange

Near the Venue, foreign currency can be exchanged from 10:00 a.m. at several “Casas de Cambio,” located at:

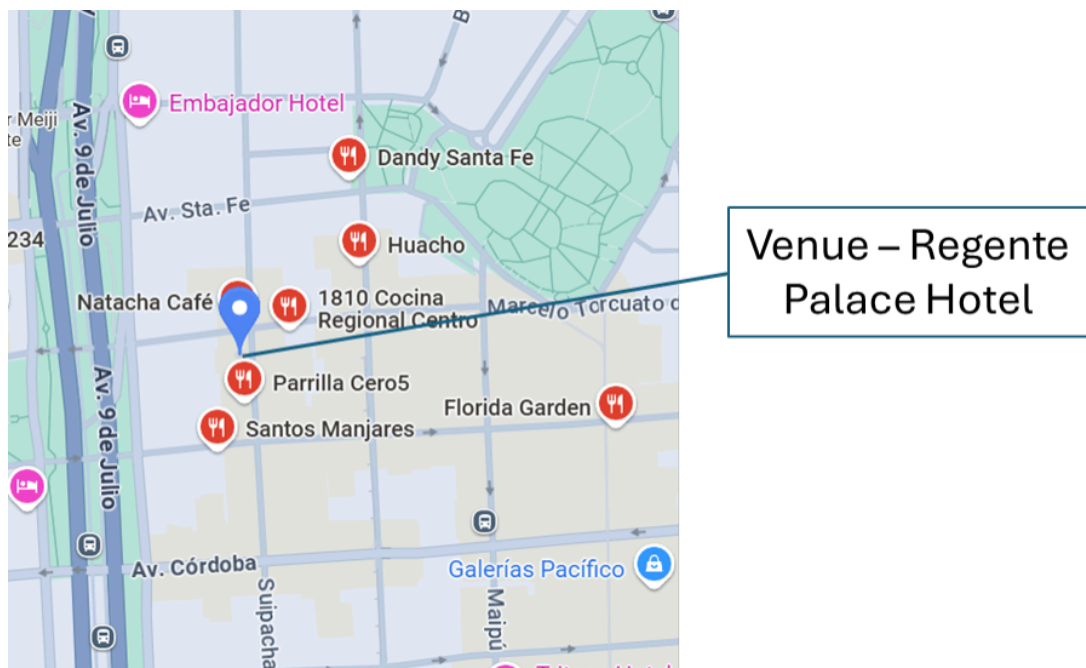

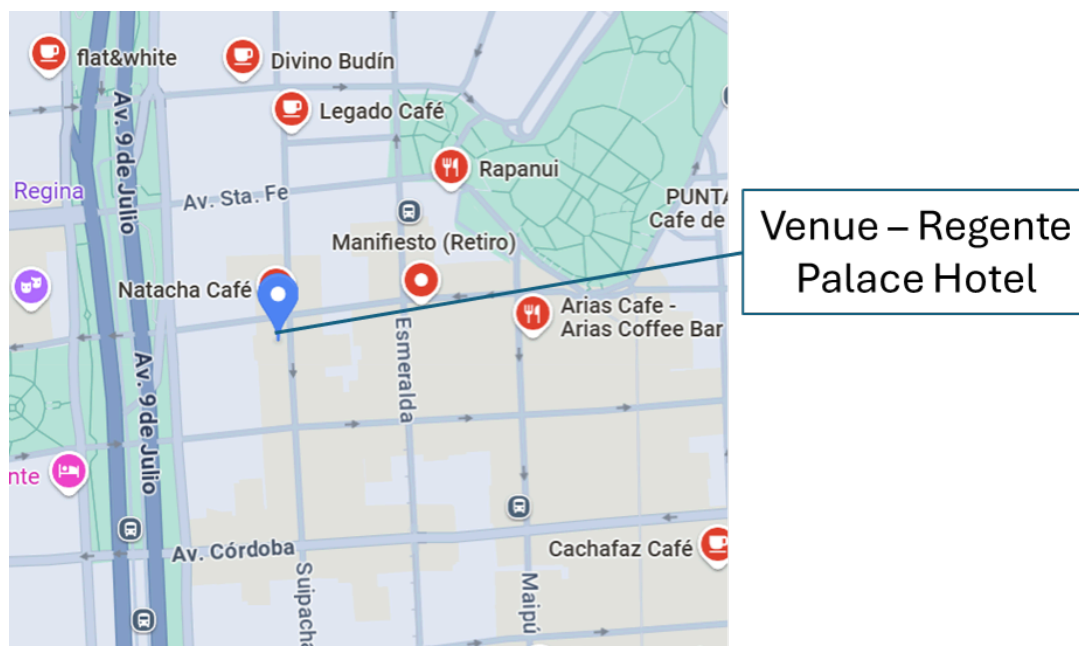

1) Tango Porteño – Cerrito 570 (4 blocks from the venue – safe area for walking)

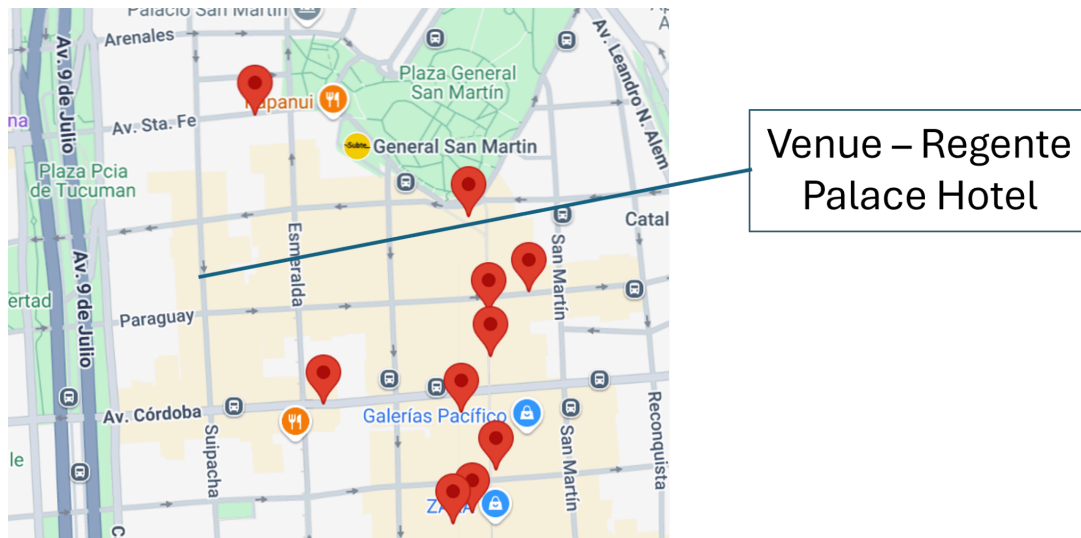
- Friday, July 18:
